## WHAT IS A CONTAMINATION LAB?



It is a place of cross-fertilisation between university students (and others) of different disciplines.

It promotes the culture of entrepreneurship, innovation and interdisciplinarity.

Cross-fertilization is the result of interaction among:

- **1.students** attending different courses of studies
- **2.students and professors/lecturers** with different backgrounds, coming from various departments and scientific areas
- **3.third actors** companies, startups, investors, business and entrepreneurial associations, incubators, coworking, etc
- **4.international actors**, who present best practices, help building international networks and offer students opportunities for mobility abroad.

## **Contamination lab: learning models**



### A contamination program is based on new learning models, that:

- stimulate participants' creativity, vocations and talents
- encourage collaboration
- increase soft skills
- stimulate team-working ability
- stimulate and support entrepreneurial ideas proposed by groups of students with different disciplinary backgrounds.

**TEA - Total Early-stage Entrepreneurial Activity rate -** Percentage of the adult population (18-64) that are in the process of starting or who have just started a business.

## The Italian situation - The general framework



### **GEM (Global Entrepreneurship Monitor) data**

Low entrepreneurship rate in Italy = creation of new ventures by new entrepreneurs (Italy is the last in the GEM international ranking)

#### Low intention to start a business



## In Italy:

- Fear of failure is very high
- Ability to perceive opportunities is very low
- Ability to perceive capabilities is very low.

These factors hinder new business creation

## Need to promote entrepreneurship



To encourage the creation of new businesses



- Promote the growth and development of the economic system
- Stimulate innovation
- Reduce unemployment rate (especially youth unemployment rate)

## European Union key competence



Entrepreneurship = key competence, necessary for personal fulfilment, active citizenship, social cohesion and employability in a knowledge society

- 2. Communication in foreign languages
- 3. Mathematical comptence and basic competences in science and techology
- 4. Digital competence
- 5. Learning to learn
- 6. Social and civic comptences

## **Entrepreneurship: European Union key competence**



## **Entrepreneurship** is a **mind-set**.

It refers to an individual's ability to turn ideas into actions.

#### It includes:

- Initiative
- Proactivity
- Creativity
- Innovation in personal, social and working life
- Risk-taking
- Ability to plan and manage projects in order to achieve objectives.

## Why it's important to encourage entrepreneurship?



- ◆ To support individuals, not only in the workplace but also in their everyday lives at home and in society, in being aware of the context of their work and being able to seize opportunities, to work both individually than collaboratively in teams, to judge and identify one's strenghts and weaknesses, and to assess and take risks as and when warranted, is essential
- **♦** To encourage the creation of new ventures

## Importance of entrepreneurship education



#### **ITALY**

Compared to other countries, EU and non-EU, in Italian universities there are few education programs aimed at promoting entrepreneurship.

Numerous studies confirm that entrepreneurship education in universities favours the development of students' entrepreneurial spirit and the start-up of new businesses.

Entrepreneurship education can make an important contribution to the development of the Italian economic system.

Entrepreneurship = opportunity to enhance technological and humanistic knowledge and skills



## Development and validation of students' business ideas



Focus on the **business ideas proposed by the participants**: These ideas are subjected to a **self-evaluation and validation** process following a **Lean Startup approach**.

**Lean start up** = Innovative approach to carry out a project and:

- Reduce times
- Reduce costs and the likelihood of failure.

Continuous iteration between problem and customers, from the early stages of product / service development

Minimum viable product (eg simplified version of the product / service).

Learning and continuous improvement process (validated learning process) based on feedback from potential users / customers of the new product / service.

#### **BUSINESS INCUBATORS**

They favour the emergence and development of new business ideas.

EU definition: an organization that accelerates the creation of new enterprises, providing them with a wide range of integrated support services that include physical spaces, support services for business development and opportunities for integration and networking.

#### COWORKING

Workspace based on collaboration and sharing of premises, services and values.

Open place, where professionals know each other and can work together on common activities or projects.

It allows you to share ideas, knowledge and skills, network, train and grow professionally thanks to workshops, workshops and moments of informal learning.
